Ontario's Southwest Black Tourism SPARK Program

On October 11th, Ontario's Southwest Black Tourism SPARK Program was officially launched at an in-person event at Diva's Delite Caribbean Restaurant in Windsor. Amherstburg Freedom Museum Board Vice President Barbara Porter, along with other community members, has been providing feedback for this program and offered suggestions about how to engage and support underrepresented stakeholders. This program encourages Black entrepreneurs, Blackowned small businesses, and Black-led non-profits and community groups based in Ontario's Southwest to share new tourism ideas for the region. Selected applicants will receive \$3,000 in seed funds, \$2,000 in tech adaptation support, mentorship and additional partner support to help get them started. **Anyone interested, must apply by November 22, 2023**. 
At the event, Dr. Brenda McCurdy and Dr. Clarke answered questions from moderator, Sheila Wisdom,




